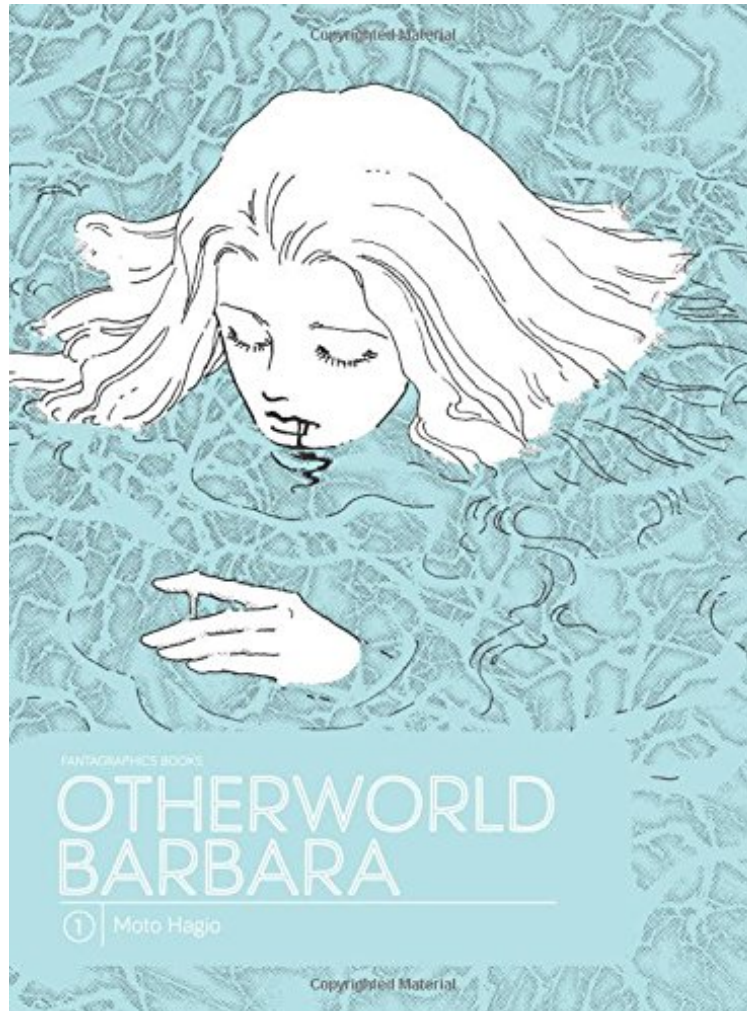

It's such a bizarre blend of paranormal and sci-fi-like plot elements, with a dream world thrown in, and it's completely absorbing once you have a context for the first chapter. The back of the book calls it a thriller and I think that's a bit strong, but there's definitely complex mystery and shocking, eerie events. Definitely down for the next volume.
