Thats an amzingly fast turn around into a trade paperback,and great timing as they took a 3 month break and issue #11 comes out later this month, so if you want to catch up on the story, then jump into the monthly issues nows the time! And of course if

you haven't already, I would definitely suggest reading Vol 1 first as it starts the characters personality developments introductions. That being said, I feel like I will wait for the next collection of books as it seems to work out better with the stories focus. Vol 1 was the introduction told through the eyes of an old man "Tootles", reflecting back on their time during WWII, and how they came to meet Peter Panzerfaust, Hook, Wendy over those five issues, leading to the (spoilers) capture of one of the lost boys "Felix" (End Spoilers). Vol 2 is the next five issues told by old man "Curly", and their plans to find and free their friend and fellow "Lost Boy" Felix. I enjoyed this volume even more than the first one! There are great action scenes, more introductions of classic Peter Pan story characters such as "Tiger Lilly" and the "Braves Chief" as new allies for Peter, Wendy and the gang. Hook makes a glorious return with his actual hook-hand now, giving a great speech about "Casting Shadows", as Peter wants to do. There is also a nice love story amid all the chaos of the WWII story between (Minor-Spoilers) Lilly and Curly (End-Spoilers), that had me smiling like an idiot. A great addition to a longer story, and I CAN NOT WAIT for the next edition Vol 3. I really like that each book is a different perspective and hope that will continue.
