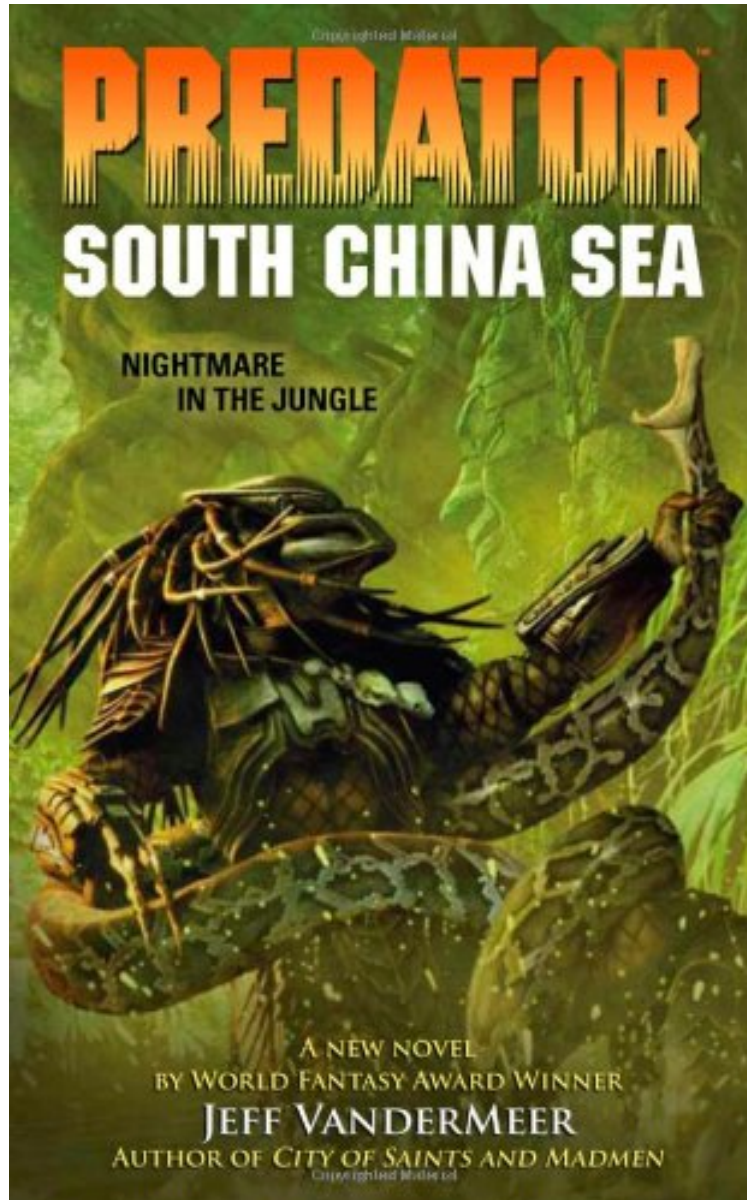

The body was great with a ton of characters that were fairly well fleshed out. You have to be able to keep up, however, as there are a lot of them and it can get easy to lose track of who is who, especially if the names are unusual to you. The book brings several different stories and sub-plots of the people together and is enjoyable. The only drawback is that it should have been at least another 30-50 pages longer and finished itself. I felt like the ending was almost rushed out like the writer wanted to get done with it or was afraid he was getting long winded, which he was not. I was starting to get hyped up at the end and was looking for a more detailed ending and was a touch disappointed with the quick finale. This, however, should not stop you from reading it.
