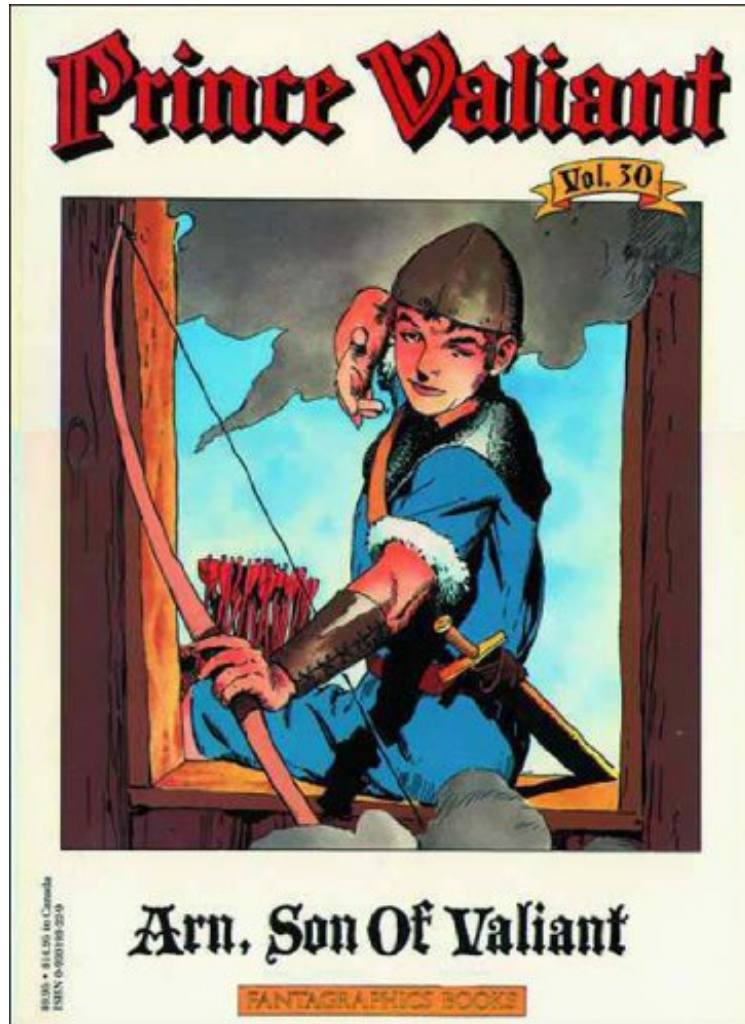

The Sunday stories are each a reasonable short story that is an integral part of the whole. The same thoughtful care was the standard when he found people who would continue the beauty, the story and the traditions.Anyone who would this a comic strip is preoccupied with the vehicle and sadly misses the beauty.
