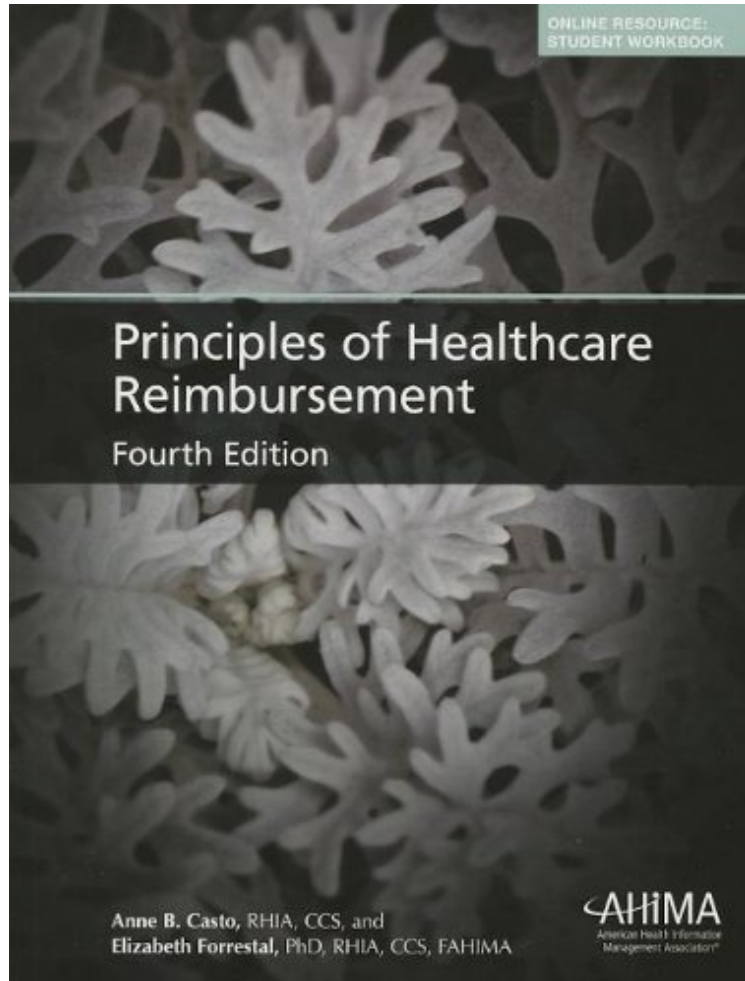

In terms of providing the necessary information, it definitely covers the bases. I feel that it is well put-together, well-organized, well-sourced and certainly covers the basics of healthcare reimbursement from methodology to payment systems to revenue cycle, and so on. I do have to agree, in part, with what some of the other reviewers have expressed - while the title is "Principles of Healthcare Reimbursement" and seems to imply (at least to me) that it's an introductory text for people new to the material, I'm not sure it's the best text for that particular audience. I've been working in healthcare for some years and use this text to help refresh myself on the

various payment systems and methodologies from time to time (i.e. getting back to basics) but I would have to say that my existing knowledge of the material definitely helps. If I were brand new to the subject, I'm almost certain that I would find the text extremely dry and, at times, nearly incomprehensible. Having said that, it is clearly intended to be a college/university-level textbook and so I think it's to be expected that the material was written organized in a certain fashion (more formal and academic) which might require a greater degree of effort to really grasp if you're not accustomed to that particular style. Overall, I think it's a good text but pricey for what it is. For the list price, I would have preferred to see more.
