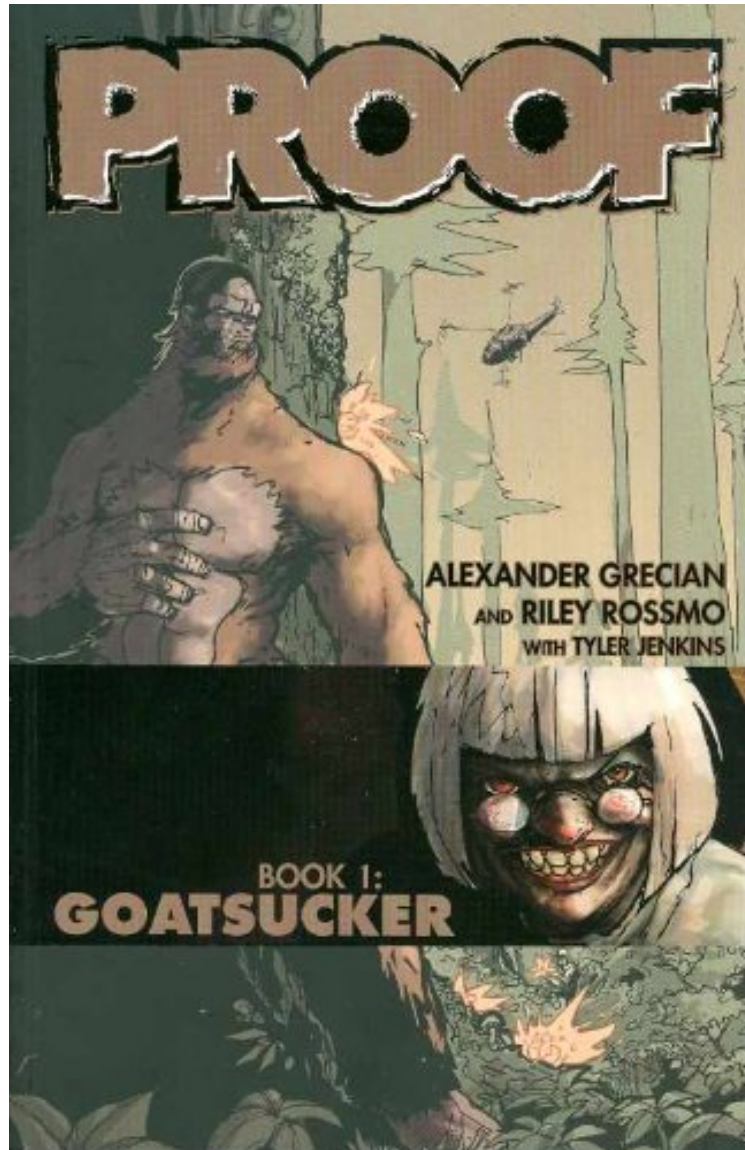

I hadn't heard of either of these artists/writers before, but I found the idea of this comic so compelling that I had to give it a try, and for only \$10, I couldn't go wrong.Reading Goatsucker really reminded me of two X-Files episodes, The Jersey Devil, and El Mundo Gira. This 1st book introduces us to the cast of characters which include an FBI Agent, Bigfoot, and Fairies who have a taste for flesh. Ginger and Proof are sent to investigate a Chupacabra sighting in Minnesota, but all does not go well. They are forced to track down this "Goatsucker" by following it's trail of victims.I especially liked this character whom they haven't really fully established yet. It's a "Dover Demon" which has no mouth yet can talk and predicts the future. Apparently, it exists in the past, present, and future, and it can communicate between it's various existences. They use this character at the end of the book to foreshadow the next story arc. Brilliant! I give this book a 4/5, and it was a great read, well structured, but I'm not head-over-heels in love with it.
