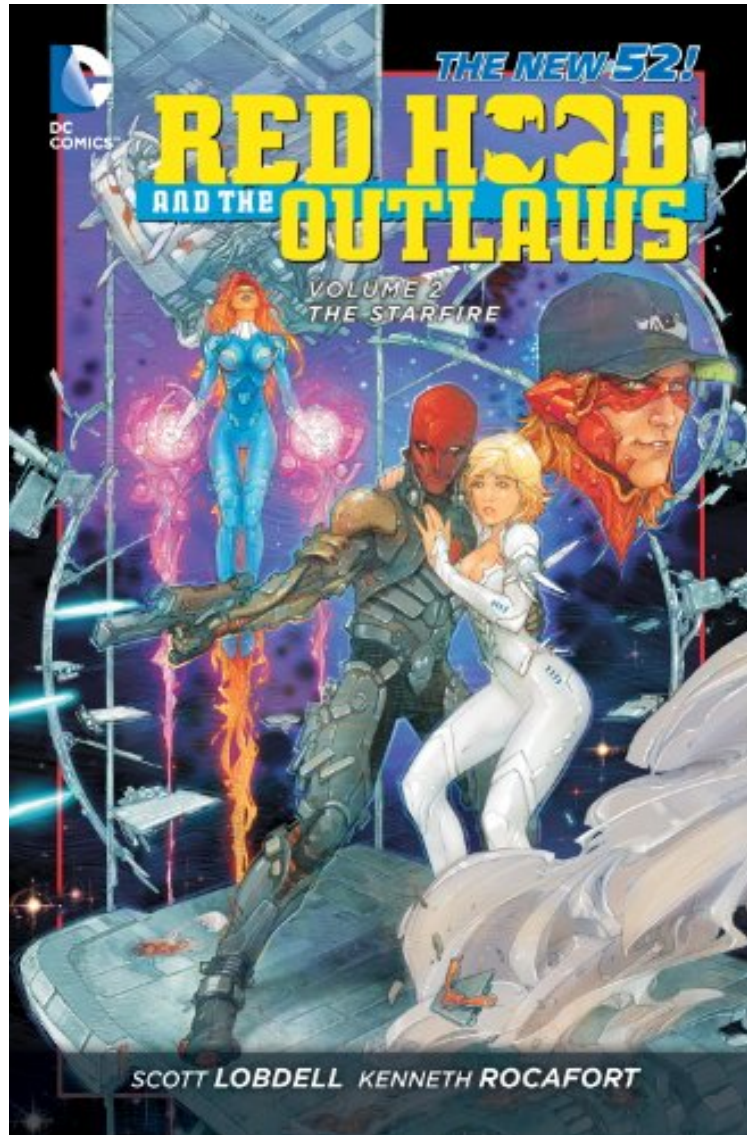

Scott Lobdell creates yet another thrill-ride within Red Hood and the Outlaws volume 2, Starfire. Red, Arsenal, and Starfire find themselves working more as a team now, more than ever. Suzie Su (volume 1) wakes enraged out of a coma and seeks revenge on the Outlaws as she threatens to murder kids in the hospital. The court of owls and Mr. Freeze hit the streets of Gotham (also found in a chapter of Batman hardcover). Red goes on a date, but before he seals the deal he finds himself teleported into space where Starfire attempts to rescue both her sister and her home planet from invasion. The Outlaws also have a run in with Superman, who apparently doesn't like to ask for help when a dark race is set free (Essence). Last but definitely not least, the most feared/iconic villain comes back to finish what he started...the Joker wants the life of Jason Todd! I was actually surprised how much I got into this story. At times it seemed like it moved a little too fast, I also had already read the second chapter which was previously in the Batman court of owls hardcover. Although, I enjoyed it all none the less and plan to continue with Death of the Family. I give Starfire 4.2/5 stars.

Part of the DC Comics - The New 52, this volume collects the second action-packed arc of New York Times best selling author Scott Lobdell. As if Batman's former sidekick Jason Todd, now known as the Red Hood, didn't have enough problems leading the team of outlaws such as Arsenal and Starfire, now his "estranged" brother Red Robin is knocking on his door because "The Night of Owls" is here! With Batman in dire need of help, will Red Hood answer the call? And when Jason and the team find out that Starfire is one of the most feared (and dangerous) commanders in all of space, the team will find their adventures taken to the stars and beyond to help decide the fate of the throne of Tamaran. Witness the galactic struggle between Starfire and her sister Blackfire as Red Hood and the Outlaws are caught in the middle of an interstellar war!
