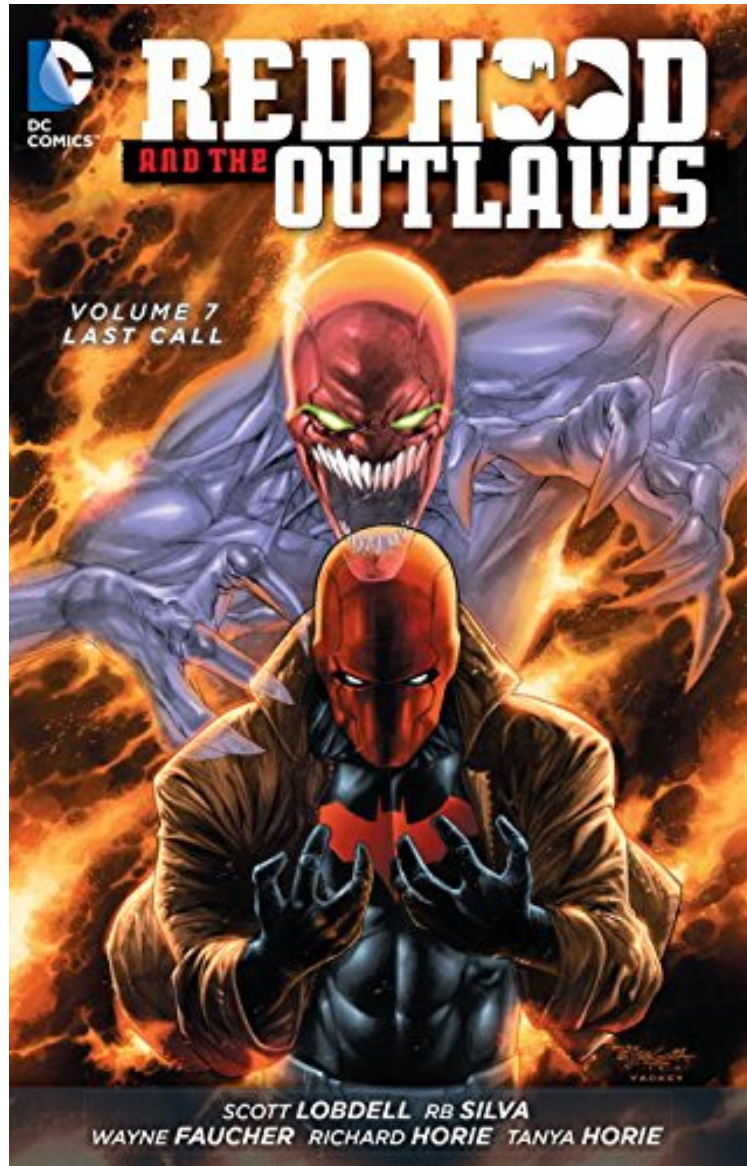

There's a subplot with Venom that is just seemingly dropped, another subplot with Roy and Oliver Queen that might as well have been the main story arc since most of the time was spent with those two characters, and the main plot involving Starfire was rushed. One moment she runs away cause "she's not okay" and subsequently starts taking some drug, the next issue she's completely fine with no explanation, and then in the final issue out of nowhere there's an alien invasion to bring our three heroes back together.
