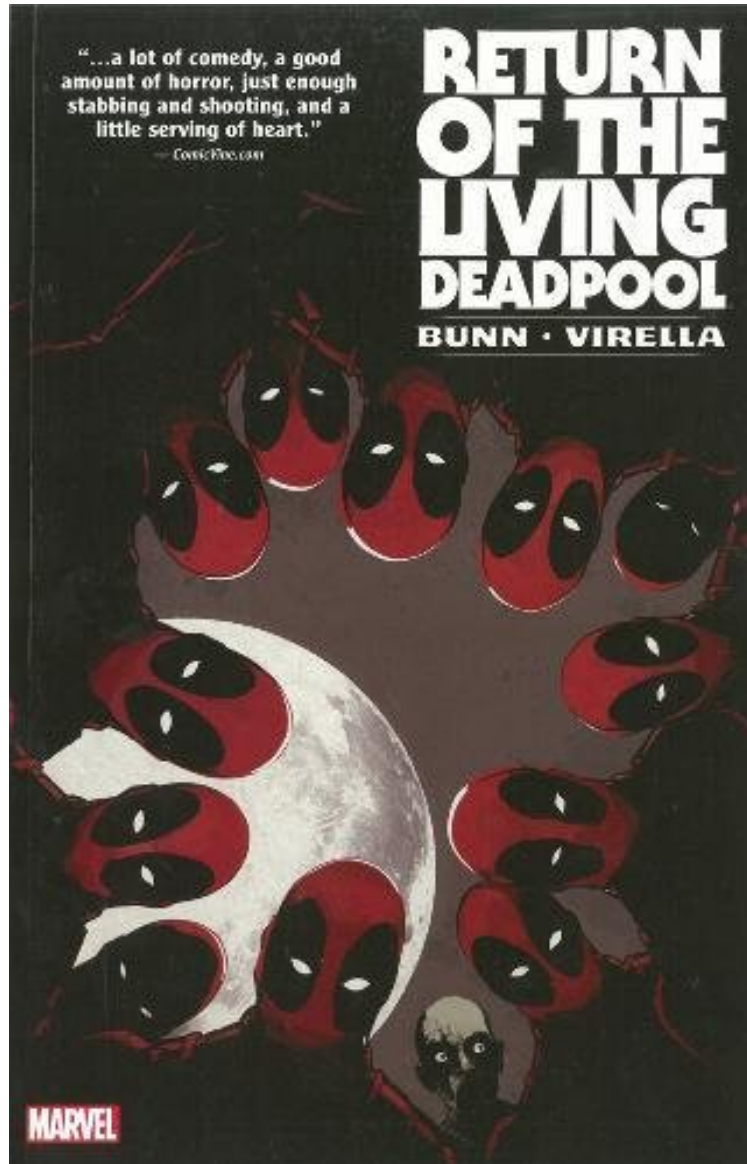

Cullen Bunn and Nik Virella have fun with this one, and the visual parodies really work. Much of the dialogue, however, is more sporadic: some of lines from Bunn's Deadpool are hilarious, others are standard fair and highly dated. Furthermore, it

suffers from a real inconsistency of tone and doesn't seem to really work with its premise as much as one would hope.
