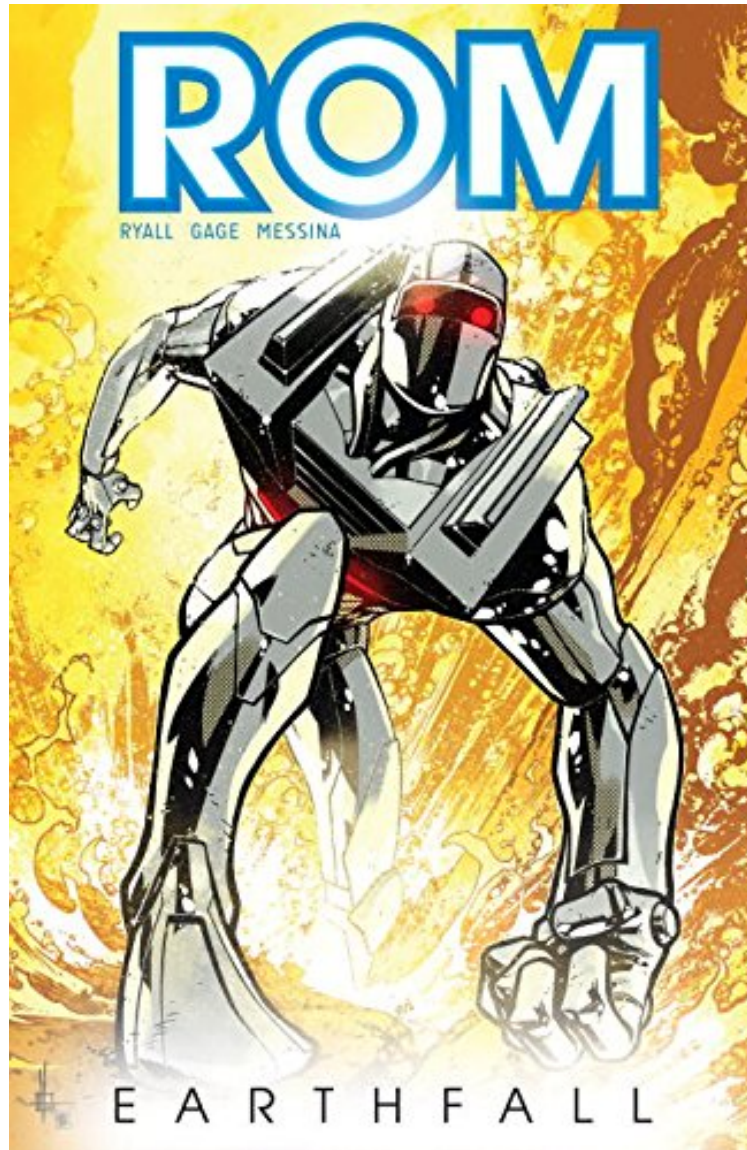

It had looked like the Micronauts and ROM series would never be updated. However, the acquisition of the Hasbro license by IDW resurrected them. It's a reimagining of some of the best 70s space opera tales and while the epic declamations of Mantlo have given way to more modern and restrained prose, Bunn seems to "get it", and evoke a modern take of the stories of the noble and powerful Space Knight and his war against the wraiths.
