What can I say about the Rosario Vampire manga series? It's fantastic. What started out as your basic, run-of-the-mill harem series evolved into something beautiful by the end. All the characters are great, the stories are great, especially in Season II, the art gets better in each volume. I won't talk too much about everything beforehand, but just know that while the first 2 volumes of the series (Season 1), volume 3 is where things start to pick up and the author starts planting the seeds for the next arcs, which all comes down to this final volume, the big showdown between Yokai Academy and the leader and founder of Fairy Tale. The scenes between Moka and Tsukune and just absolutely beautiful and the author really brings all the build-up to their relationship and the initial confession to a beautiful close.
