Great fun for Scooby-Doo and DC Super Heroes fans By Lee Kirby If you're of a certain age, you'll remember "The New Scooby-Doo Movies," the second incarnation of Scooby-Doo that teamed the Mystery, Inc. gang with weekly guest stars including real-life celebrities and well-known cartoon characters. There are no celebrities to be found in this first collection of DC's "Scooby Doo Team-Up" series, but

there's plenty of fun to be had for both the young and the young at heart. Credit goes to writer Sholly Fisch, who lets his imagination run wild in his tales featuring the DC Universe heroes as guest-stars. He leads off the series with a multi-part story featuring Batman and Robin, who guested in two "New Scooby-Doo Movies" episodes. Along the way, the gang encounters not only Ace the Bat-Hound and Bat-Mite from the late 50s-early 60s Bat-titles, but even Scooby-Mite (yes, Scooby-Mite), an imp from Bat-Mite's fifth dimension who worships Scooby the same way Bat-Mite worships the Caped Crusader. The Super Friends also appear in a wild bookend story that sees Velma and Shaggy posing as Wendy and Marvin, the group's original junior partners, while Fred and Daphne are disguised as Zan and Jayna, the Wondertwins. Fisch's tale also involves the Legion of Doom posing as rainbow ghosts inside the great Hall of Justice so the Super Friends will be unable to defeat them. This brief summary does not begin to do this story justice (so to speak). In between, there's a team-up with Wonder Woman that sees Daphne and Velma become honorary s after training on Paradise Island...and even a guest turn by the Teen Titans of "Teen Titans Go!" Of course, Robin in that cartoon is decidedly different from the Boy Wonder of the aforementioned multi-parter, but part of the fun is that Fisch makes no effort to explain away the discrepancy. It simply is. Roll with it. In addition, series artist Dario Brizuela captures expertly the Hanna-Barbera house style in his work.
