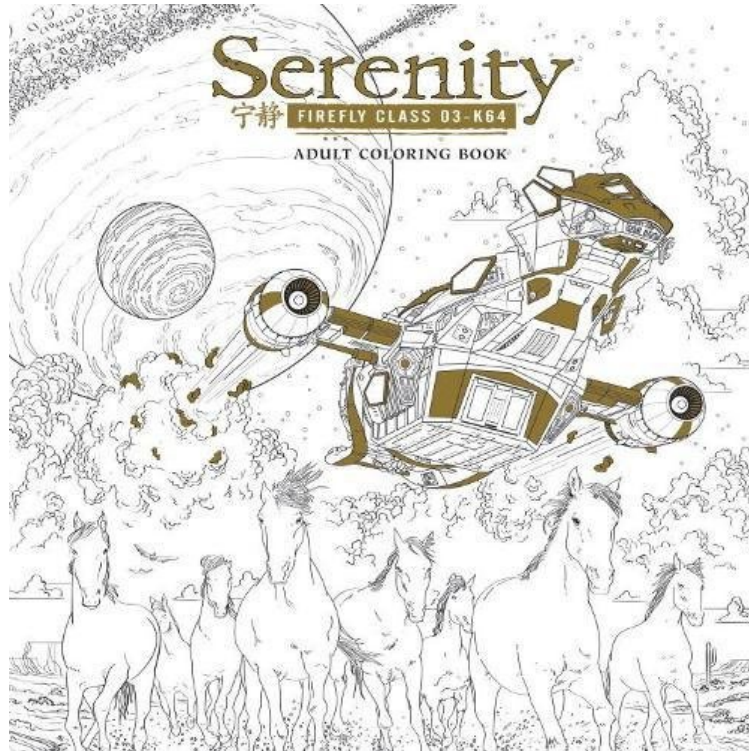

The right side pages are for coloring and the left each has a quote which I thought was a neat idea, and makes it so you're not trying to bend the spine more to get the left side flat to color. Some of the pictures are awesome and I'm looking forward to but it appears they had several people working on this and the people are done in several different styles, most of which just aren't done well. I'm probably going to skip most of the ones with people which is a majority of the book. the cover is beautiful and is also the first coloring page. then you get one from the battle of Serenity which is pretty neat. you get two pages of very cartoonish drawings of the cast, which just doesn't look attractive and I'm not interested in coloring. there's a good one of Kaylee and book when he was looking for a ship, then one of Wash on the bridge which is awesome except for how his face is drawn which pretty much ruins the page for me. then you get a couple of decent ones again and then a different style of their faces which is just... not okay. I wish whoever did the artwork on pages 15,31, 37,59,69 ect would have done the rest of the ones with crew in them. the ones with Serenity in them are all pretty awesome. I do like the order of scenes they included, it refreshes the storyline for me when I go through it. Just wish some of the quality/style of art was a bit better. The quality of the book is good, but the art....not so much.As much as I love this movie/show, it's

probably not good material for a coloring book. If you prefer (like me) to color realistically, there's not a broad range - a lot of bland shades of brown. Also, about 90% of the images are shots (or variations of) from the series and include people. Very few are object-only, and none are tessellations, which I do personally like to see sprinkled into these coloring books. Speaking of people, in a well-drawn book, these are difficult to color. These are extremely poorly done. Except for Shep and Jayne (an elderly black man and a dude with a goatee), all the men look the same. If Mal isn't wearing his coat, Wash isn't in the cockpit, or Simon isn't in a doctor outfit, you cannot tell them apart. Well, maybe Mal is recognizable one other time. The women are almost as bad. Inara is only recognizable once - in her own environment. Kaylee never looks like Kaylee, and Zoe...? There's one very good likeness, otherwise, it's a borderline stereotype of a black woman. Most of the time you have to remember what the scene is in order to identify anybody. And half the time, their mouths are drawn ridiculously overdrawn for their faces. There's enough that I find ... OK ... that it wouldn't be worth the hassle of returning, but I have seriously considered it. (And it just arrived this afternoon....) 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Four and a half stars. The tiny problem isn't worth a whole star loss. By R. Lightfoot I *really* only wanted to take off half a star for this review. On the one hand, the artwork wasn't as nice as I was hoping for in some of the pages. On the other hand, it's HUGE and there's a TON of artwork to color, and my wife, who the gift was for, thinks it's great. Like my other firefly book, we're both afraid to mess it up, so I have to buy another. And this is not a complaint - but a further revision printed with a spiral binding would make the book easier to color in, though it would take away slightly from the professionalism. I'm considering having an extra copy bound in that way just for that reason.
