This was a great entry to the Serenity comic series, though not perfect. *Firefly* and *Serenity* have long been some of my favorite things to watch, and now I can read more of the story through the 5 graphic novels that have been released to date. This is the most recent entry, and though not as strong as previous titles (*Leaves on the Wind* was nearly perfect) it is a great follow up, and if you're a fan of the universe, especially the comic extensions of the universe, you simply have to get this.
