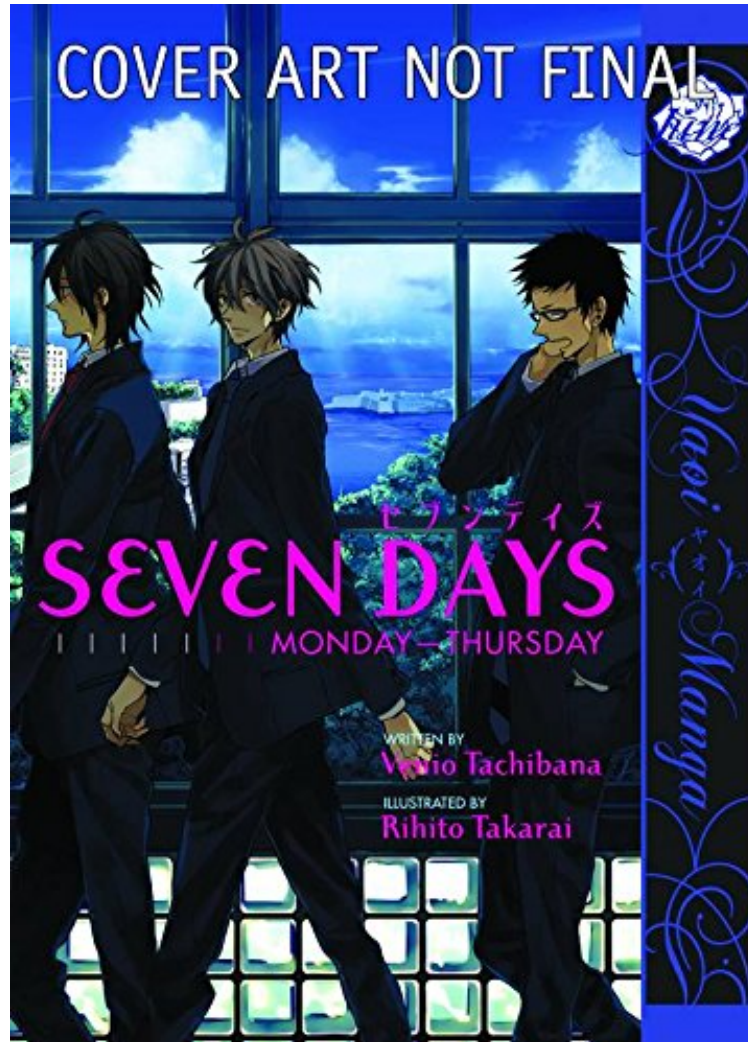

Image resolution is very low, and if you have it rotated to portrait orientation the small images are unevenly set n the screen. I had to turn to horizontal orientation before pages were reliably 2 per "screen" and of course they're still small. Zooming in was necessary several times, which made for pixelated fine text, and disturbingly normal size to continue reading was annoying. And a second boy who desperately wants to fall in love again, but will only give the girls one week. Yes, one of them might be a bit immature, and the other might be a bit of a masochist, but they're just people with faults any reader can relate to; they aren't perfect, and they know it.When they agree to date, it's a simple encounter, an amusing misunderstanding. And yet the storyline is never, ever contrived -- it never comes off as cheap. There's a poignant sweetness to this story I have yet to encounter anywhere else, an indescribable beauty.I've read this story many times and it never gets old.
